Shortbread Recipe

This is the easy put it all in the food processor recipe!

8 oz plain flour

4 oz icing sugar

3 oz cornflour

Pinch salt

Pinch baking powder

8 oz cold butter (cut in cubes)

Put all ingredients into food processor and whizz together until a ball of dough forms.

Roll into a sausage shape and put in fridge for 30 mins.

Cut into slices, prick and bake on tray for approx 25 – 30 minutes at 160C.
