NEEDS LIST - NEEDLETURN APPLIQUE CLASS

12" square background fabric Four x 3" squares for leaves

Eight x 3 ¼ " squares for hearts One x 2" square for centre

One bias strip of fabric 1" wide and 16"long. **Before** class, fold this in ½ lengthwise, **wrong sides** together, machine

the length slightly less than 1/4 " from cut edges.

Hand needles (applique are best)

Thread to match fabrics (100% cotton preferable)

Small, pointed, sharp scissors Pins (applique or sequin if you have them)

One x 2" square strong, thin, card (eg, from inside pantyhose pack) – using a 50c piece as template, mark a circle on

this card and cut out carefully.

The following if you have them:- Fine tip HB propelling pencil Quilt-marking pencils

Fine tip washaway markers Chalk pencils

HB pencil with good pencil sharpener

Fine tip Bic black biro (with yellow shaft)

Stall Holders \square A large trestle table is available for each stall holder. \square The stall is mainly for the sale of fabric, fabric remnants and sewing accessories, such as patterns, thread, beads, buttons, haberdashery and also remnants of wool. It's easier if you measure and price fabrics beforehand. \square You can include a small number of fabric and wool-made crafts – but the main thing is the fabric! \square You need to be set up and ready to go by 10:30 am – pack up at 3:00 pm. \square You need to be available on the day to man the stall. \square Cost of stall \$25.00.
Payment details □ Payment in advance – minimum of one week's notice of cancellation. □ Confirm your interest by returning the tear off form below by email or letter. □ Make payment into the Soroptimist bank account or pay by cheque.
