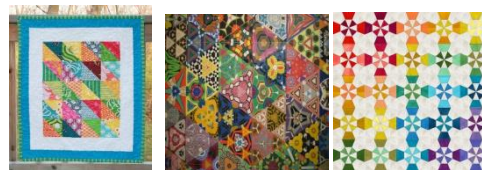
We will present certificates to the winners of the categories at our AGM and there will be goodies for supper so come along to the evening.
